The Protecting God's Children program, for adults, emphasizes that people, especially those who have direct contact with minors, should know the early warning signs of an inappropriate "relationship" with a young person. The program educates individuals about the warning signs that can identify potential abuse before it happens. Also, if adults know the warning signs, we do not have to rely solely on a child to report an incident. The program is intended to raise one's awareness of other people's behavior as well as their own behavior in order to avoid a "lapse of judgement".
